## CITY OF HINTON COUNCIL MEETING APRIL 21, 2016 5:30 P.M.

LAND SALE HEARING RESOLUTION #794:

**BDB ENTERPRISES:**

The City of Hinton has been in negotiations with BDB Enterprises on a possible new development to the West of Eagle View Subdivision. The estimate on the improvements (road, water, sewer etc.) is \$620,000.00. The following is the final proposal from the City of Hinton: BDB Enterprises would pay \$300,000.00 and the City of Hinton would pay the remainder of the improvement costs and all interest providing the bids don't come in substantially higher than the estimate. Net cost to the City of Hinton would be estimated between \$400,000.00 and \$475,000.00 for the improvements. The area would be put in an urban renewal area and TIF would be used to finance the project. The City of Hinton would pay BDB Enterprises \$75,000.00 for a lot to the west of the proposed addition to be used for water storage/well in the future. BDB Enterprises would not pay any upfront money for the improvements and would pay the City back \$225,000.00 (\$300,000.00 less \$75,000.00) when lots are sold. This amount must be repaid within 10 years and is interest free. No agreement was reached.

Motion to adjourn by Kreber, seconded by Johnson, all aye, meeting adjourned 5:40 p.m.
